ORDER

Subject :- Financial assistance for the "Pre-Operative Programme for Indian Participation in the FAIR Project at GSI, Darmstadt, Germany – Accelerator and Detector-Related R&D and Prototyping" to various Indian research and educational institutions (listed in Annexure-I).

Sanction of the President is hereby accorded for grant of the above-mentioned project at a total cost of Rs. 9,54,26,600/- (Rupees nine crore fifty four lakh twenty six thousand six hundred only) for a duration of one year to various research and educational institutions in the country as given in Annexure-I. The items of expenditure for which the total allocation of Rs. 9,54,26,600/- has been approved for various research and educational institutions for a period of 1 year are given in Annexure-II.

2. Out of the total sanctioned amount of Rs. 9,54,26,600/-, Rs. 4,99,82,000/- (Rupees four crore ninety nine lakh eighty two thousand only) shall be contributed by the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) and Rs. 4,54,44,600/- (Rupees four crore fifty four lakh forty four thousand six hundred only) shall be contributed by the Department of Science and Technology (DST). The agency-wise, item-wise and institution-wise break-up of the budget are given in Annexure-III and Annexure-IV.

3. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and benefits to the staff employed in the project etc.

4. Sanction of the grant is subject to the conditions as detailed at the website www.serc-dst.org under "Guidelines for Implementing Research Projects".

5. The sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Ministries and with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division of Department of Science & Technology vide Dy. No. IFD/1811/2008-09 dated 24.3.2009.


6. The institutions will furnish to the DST, utilization certificate and audited statement of accounts pertaining to the grant immediately after the end of each financial year.

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
7. The institutions will maintain separate audited accounts for the project. If it is found expedient to keep a part or whole of the grant in a bank account earning interest, the interest earned should be reported to the DST. The interest thus earned will be treated as a credit to the institutions to be adjusted towards further instalment of the grant.

8. As per Rule 211 GFRs, the accounts of the project shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority / audit whenever the institutions are called upon to do so.
