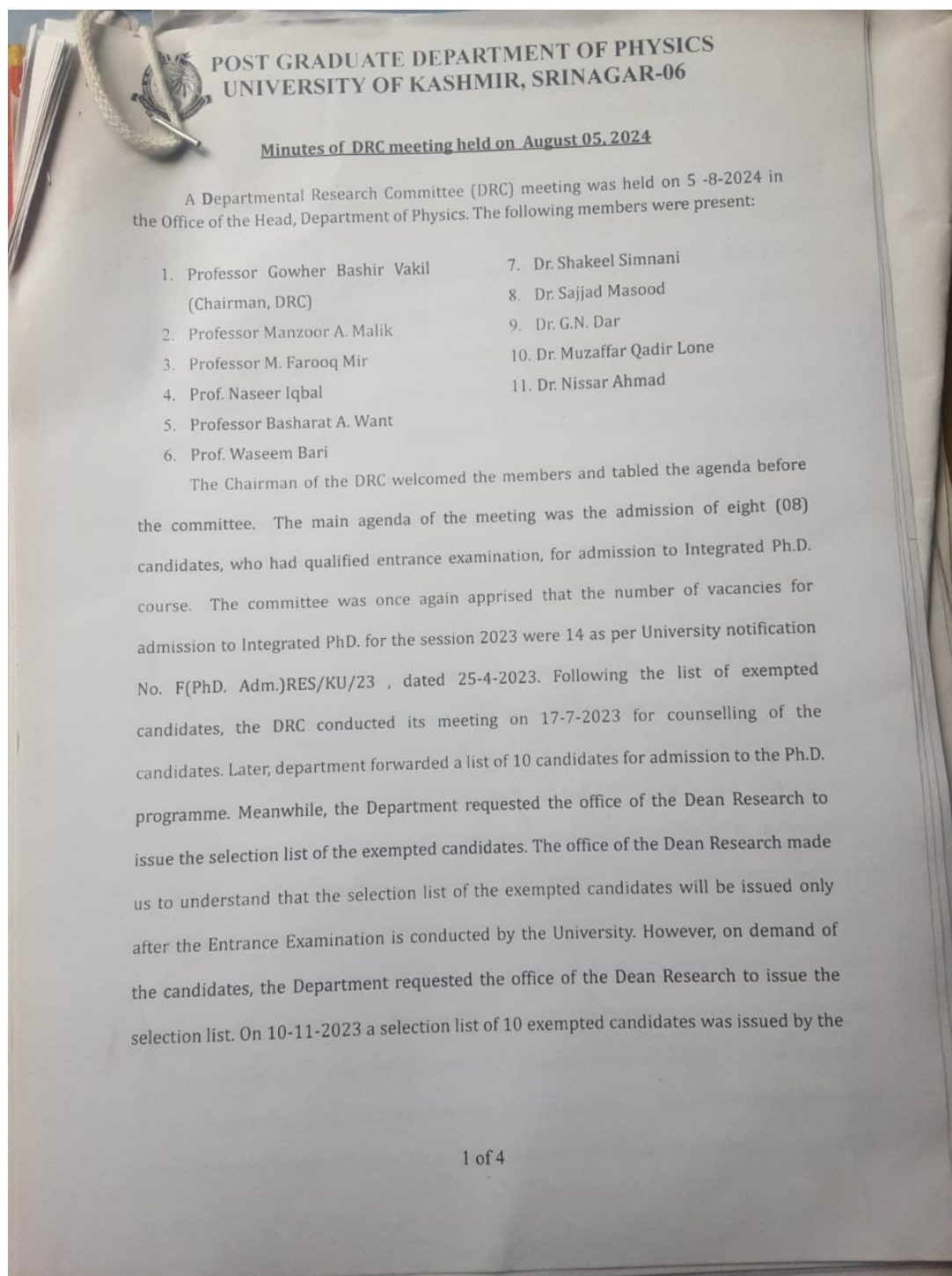

Dean, School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences. Out of 10 candidates, two were selected under the In-Service Category and were asked to obtain the permission from their parent departments. **Out of 10 selected candidates only 06 completed their admission formalities before 08-12-2023.** Meanwhile, the University conducted Entrance Examination for left over vacancies on 9-1-2024 and declared the results on 29-1-2024. However, the department did not communicate the number of left over vacancies from the exempted candidates owing to the fact that the list (at S.No. 9 and 10) contained two In-Service candidates , who are given some time to complete the NOC formalities from the parent departments. Moreover, a candidate at S.No. 8 , selected under INSPIRE category, also requested some time to submit the fellowship certificate from the concerned quarters. However, the candidates from S.No. 8-10 did not join for the PhD programme for not getting the requisite documents (NOC from parent department/INSPIRE certificate), besides the candidate at S.No. 07 also did not join the programme. Subsequently, keeping these facts in mind, the department held a DRC counselling meeting on 30-3-2024 and requested the higher authorities for provisional admission of all the 14 candidates who had qualified the Entrance test. However, the request for allowing admission to all 14 candidates was declined owing to the statutory limitations. The Department accepted the decision of the competent authority. Subsequently, a DRC meeting was once again convened on 10-7-2024 to submitted a fresh proposal to the Dean Research, requesting admission to only 08 candidates who have qualified the Entrance Examination. However, the Department received a letter from Dean, School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences, dated 24-7-2024, as to explain why the Department has not implemented the authorised list of 04 candidates vide No.F(Admsn-Phy)Res/KU/24 Dated 30-5-204 and why Department has forwarded afresh

revised list of eight candidates although the number of vacancies is only 04. In order, to address the queries raised by the Dean Research, a DRC meeting was convened today under the chairman ship of HOD. The DRC discussed various aspects of the matter and provided the justification as under:

1. The formal orders for selection list of four candidates, approved by the competent authority, was not issued by the Dean, School of Physical and Mathematical Sciences. A query was raised by the Dean Faculty regarding the merit of the candidate at S.No. 04 . Moreover ,the dispute of taking 8 candidates instead of 04 was not resolved..
2. The DRC was apprised by the Chairman that the HoD, Prof. Gowher Bashir along with Prof. Basharat Ahmad Want (former HoD) met the Dean Research in his office chamber, on July , to discuss the matter. The Dean Research verbally suggested the Department to put up a fresh proposal recommending only 08 candidates with suitable justifications. Further, it is the fact that Department had 08 vacancies (which were advertised for the Entrance Examination). **So, the DRC deemed it appropriate in the interest of the PhD aspirant and the available vacancies in the Department to propose the provisional admission to 08 candidates.** Now once again, the department has decided unanimously to submit a list of 08 candidates, who had qualified the entrance examination, for recommendation to Integrated Ph.D. program.

In light of the above, the Department has now once again decided to recommend only 08 candidates, as per the merit, for the admission to Ph.D. programme in Physics.

The Assistant Registrar, (Research) was also present.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in his introductory thanked all the members for their unstinted efforts in ensuring a successful visit of the Peer Team of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) that resulted in reaccreditation of the University as a Grade A⁺ University by the NAAC, Bangaluru. The Vice Chancellor impressed upon the members to further raise the standards of research in the School and undertake quality research in emerging areas in collaboration with researchers in Centres of Excellence both within the country and abroad. The Vice-Chancellor further desired that:

1. Topics of research to be assigned to the scholars should be discussed thoroughly in pre-BORS meetings and inputs from the experts in the area of research should be sought in whatever manner possible.
2. Regular review of work carried out by the scholars during the research degree programme should be undertaken by the Research Progress Assessment Committee (RPAC) in accordance with the provisions of the statutes.
3. Also it was emphasized that the course work examination should be conducted on time and dates for the purpose should be notified by the Deans of the Schools well in advance. Marks sheets giving details of the marks obtained in the three course work papers should be issued to the scholars for which modalities be worked out.

In his remarks Dean Research invited the attention of the members toward the following points:

1. Attention needs to be paid to some key indicators, such as patent filing and award, innovations, corporate funding for trainings, funding from non-government sources under the Criteria III (Research, Innovation and Extension) of Assessment and Accreditation and further progress/improvement in respect of other key indicators in which the University had a stellar performance during the recently concluded 3rd cycle of assessment by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangaluru.

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Boards of Research Studies should come up with well thought out programmes and policies for promotion of research and innovation in the University which could then be discussed and deliberated upon in the Research Council and other competent bodies of the University.

3. Progress of work of the scholars admitted to research degree programmes be regularly and effectively monitored for better outcomes.

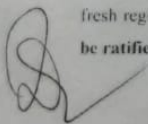
